

AGUENAR/TAMANRASSET (TMR/DAAT)

Elevation 4518ft

GENERAL

- Hadj Bey Akhamok Airport, a.k.a Aguenar Airport, a.k.a Tamanrasset Airport is located 6.7 km northwest of the city of Tamanrasset in Tamanrasset Province in southern Algeria.
- Air Algérie and Tassili Alrlines fly to a handful of destinations from DAAT, but the main user of the airport is the Algerian Air Force. The airport was one of the alternate landing sites for NASA's Space Shuttle.
- The terrain north and east of the airport rises towards the Hoggar Mountains. The highest peak is Mount Tahat (9852ft) which is the highest point in Algeria.

Threats

CFIT

When departing runway 02 or 08 care must be taken to clear terrain. No published SIDs.

Runway Incursion

 There is a very short distance from the apron to the runway entry points D, E and F. Do not enter the runway without permission from ATC. Also be aware that runway 08/26 crosses runway 02/20.

Mid Air Collision

Don't be fooled by the 3500m runway. This is a small airport. Given the time of day, the amount
of WorldFlight traffic will be significant. The lack of STARs and SIDs will increase the risk of
incidents.

Special Considerations

Stray dogs on movement area. Birds in vicinity of airport.

Approach

- No published STARs. Expect radar vectors to final or to fly the ILS with DME arc approach (Rwy 08 and 20)
- Expect heavy WorldFlight traffic and possible delays. Few suitable alternate airports nearby, make sure you carry enough fuel.

AGUENAR/TAMANRASSET (TMR/DAAT)

GROUND

- Very limited apron space, especially for code E acft.
- Expect Worldflight-style parking, possibly along Twy M. Note: Twy G is a high-speed runway exit and NOT suitable for parking without prior permission from your insurance company.

DEPARTURE

- No published SIDs
- If ATC is offline, it is recommended to fly the departure along the missed approach path for the take-off runway until above the MSA.

WEATHER

- Tamanrasset has a hot desert climate.
- Daily highs in Aguenar in November ranges from 10C to 25C with very little precipitation.
