GENERAL

- Luxembourg is a very small country, be careful not to miss it.
- Whilst there are RNAV transitions for arrival, be aware that you will likely receive shortcuts so may be late warnings of descent, plan accordingly

Threats

Runway Incursion

 Multiple entries on to the runway, be cautious to always hold short at stipulated holding point as instructed by ATC

Approach

• You will likely initially be given an RNAV transition, then the controller (like they do) will change their mind and give you radar vectors. Thus your track miles may significantly shorten resulting in the use of Dan Parkin's favourite flight control, the speedbrake.

GROUND

• Ample parking both north and south of the runway, please use all available stands to avoid congestion around main terminal and cargo apron.

WEATHER

- In general, in November, weather is shambolic in Europe so expect it to be wetter than wet.
- Fog can be an issue however I'm not a Mystic Meg and thus you'll need to check the METAR to check if it's foggy
