Approach

 To perform visual approach to RWY 08 or RWY 26, the ACFT must intercept RWY axis minimum at 2000ft.

GROUND

 Marshaller required for stands B01 thru B017, C10 thru C13 and D4E/D4W thru D7E/D7W on arrival.

DEPARTURE

- De-icing of ACFT only permitted on apron B.
- Pilots must reach 3160ft as quickly as possible.

WEATHER

 Lille experiences a temperate oceanic climate. Summers are usually mild to moderately warm, with temperatures ranging from around 15°C to 25°C (59°F to 77°F). Winters tend to be cold,
