GENERAL

- Punta Cana International Airport is located in Punta Cana, Dominican Republic. It is the second busiest in the Caribbean.
- Airfield situated on the East coast of the island on a flat area. Terrain starts to rise 18 nm to the West reaching 2500 ft AMSL approx 29 nm in a NW direction.
- Terrain rises to over 10000ft AMSL in the centre of the island (150nm W of airport)

APPROACH

- No ILS approaches
- A new Rwy 08/26 is now open north of Rwy 09/27. Ensure you line up with the correct runway.
- Rwy 08/26 preferred for landing

GROUND

- When landing Rwy 09: vacate A to allow departing traffic to use B
- Limited parking

DEPARTURE

- Preferred Rwy for take-off is 08/26.
- RNAV SIDs available, but ATC will often clear you to climb straight ahead to 3000' and then turn you to your first waypoint.

WEATHER

- Punta Cana experiences a tropical climate with a cool season Nov-Apr with low humidity and little precipitation. Hot season is May-Oct with higher humidity and frequent rainstorms.
- Hurricanes possible during Caribbean hurricane season (Jun-Nov). Punta Cana most at risk later in the season.
