

COMODORO RIVADAVIA (CRD/SAVC)

Elevation 185ft

GENERAL

- General Enrique Mosconi Intl serves the city of Comodoro Rivadavia in southern Argentina
- The airport is located on the coast 5 nm N of the city
- On 22 November 2017 the longest non-stop flight ever made by the RAF landed at the airport

Threats**CFIT**

- Terrain rises inland to 2,700ft amsl within 15 NM

Runway Excursion

- RNP Rwy 07 has a 3.3 degree glidepath
- Rwy 07/25 is 50m wide and may give the impression of being low. This is exacerbated by the fact that Rwy 07 has a considerable downslope.
- Rwy 07 threshold considerably inset (LDA 2060m)

GROUND

- The airport slopes considerably from west to east. Give careful consideration to the expected taxi route before shutting down an engine.

- Comodoro Rivadavia is one of the southernmost locations to have a subtropical climate
- Summers (Jan-Mar) are warm to hot and dry with average temperatures around 19°C
- Winters (Jul-Sep) are mild
