

**WINNIPEG (YWG/CYWG)**

Elevation 783ft

**CATEGORY A**

AV brief not required

**GENERAL**

- James Armstrong Richardson International Airport is situated on the western outskirts of Winnipeg, the capital and largest city of Manitoba
- The city is home to several professional sports franchises including the Winnipeg Blue Bombers, Winnipeg Jets, Manitoba Moose, Valour FC and the Winnipeg Goldeneyes.
- Lake Winnipeg, from which the city takes its name, is 30 nm N of the city
- YWG is the seventh-busiest airport in Canada by passenger traffic and the 11<sup>th</sup> busiest by aircraft movements

**Threats****Runway Incursion**

- Intersecting runway used for departures and arrivals

**Runway Excursion**

- Runways are 61m wide which may lead to a sensation of being low whilst on the correct profile. This is particularly true for Rwy 13/31 due to its shorter length

**ARRIVAL****Diversion Airports**

**Approach**

- IFR aircraft are required to cross the FAF at 170 kt or less unless otherwise instructed by ATC

**DEPARTURE**

- Use FCOM2 noise abatement procedure, terminating altitude 4,000ft.

**WEATHER**

- Nov-Mar: snow falls on average 8 days per month but with maximum fall in March. Wind mainly NW often exceeding 20kt. Mainly stratiform cloud with base 2000ft and visibility 10km. Conditions below 200ft/800m less than 10% of the time.
- May-Sep: Rain replaces snow in mid-May. Thunderstorms most frequent in July. Conditions seldom below 300ft/2000m
- April and October are transitional months with wind from the east. Fog/low St may occur.
