**Approach**

- Noise abatement procedures require pilots to maintain a Continuous descent approach where able.

**GROUND**

- Code D and E aircraft should exercise caution when entering or exiting Runway at A1 or B1 to ensure all wheels remain on the paved surface.
- Stands 1-9 and 11-18 have marshaller guidance
- Stand 10 has safe dock available.

**WEATHER**

- Poor visibility due to industrial haze may occur in settled conditions as well as radiation fog
