

Atlanta (ATL/KATL)

Elevation 1026ft

CATEGORY A

AV brief – not required.

GENERAL

- Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport is located 10 miles south of Downtown Atlanta.
- In 2022, KATL was the busiest airport in the world by passenger numbers with over 93.6 million passengers.
- KATL is the only active civil airport in the US to have a runway crossing an Interstate Highway.
- Simultaneous approaches may be conducted with parallel runways.
- As with all operations within US FAA airspace, anticipate a landing clearance with other aircraft in front of you on the approach.

- Highest MSA to 25Nm is 3,100ft.
- The shortest runway is 2,743m (9,000ft).
- In summary, the terrain is flat, the runways are long.

GROUND

- CAUTION: Numerous runway crossing clearances.

DEPARTURE

- Pilots and crews should be aware of departure turns on course in excess of 180°. Pilots readback of direction of turn is highly encouraged.
- Pushback is at the crew's discretion unless otherwise advised, call ground for taxi instructions. Not that gate A36 pushes back onto an active taxiway and does require permission.
- Taxi to the north or south hold point on the ramp and call the appropriate ground controller.

WEATHER

- Overcast ceilings are the predominant sky condition from November until May.
- Wind direction is generally from the northwest in November.
